3GG's 100 Grand for Gippsland

TERMS & CONDITIONS

These contest rules apply to the “**3GG's 100 Grand for Gippsland**” radio contest.

1. THE PROMOTER:

“3GG's 100 Grand for Gippsland” is a Capital Radio 3GG Gippsland competition, collectively operating as the promoter.

2. WHO MAY ENTER:

All entrants must be 18 years or older and reside in Victoria.

– You are ineligible to enter a competition if:

1. you are an employee of, or contractors to, the Promoter or any of its agencies involved with this competition; or
2. you are the spouse, de facto spouse, parent, natural or adopted child, and sibling (whether natural or adopted by a parent), of such employees and contractors (whether or not they live in the same household).
3. you have won a prize/prizes valued either individually or collectively at more than \$100 from the Promoter or in any contest run by the Promoter in the prior 30 days.
4. you have been discovered to have used or attempted to use any more than one name in order to qualify to win any contest run by the Promoter except in the case of a legal change of name.
5. you have won a prize valued at \$1,000 or more from the Promoter or in any contest run by the Promoter in the prior 90 days.
6. you have won a prize valued at \$5,000 or more from the Promoter or in any contest run by the Promoter in the prior 12 months.
7. you are an employee of any broadcast station within NSW, ACT, VIC or WA.
8. you have been an employee of the Promoter within the last 60 days.

All contestants acknowledge that the Promoter can rely on Clause 2 and even if the Promoter only learns of a person's ineligibility after the Promoter has appeared to award the prize to the ineligible person. Return of the prize or payment of its value to the Promoter can be required by the Promoter if this occurs.

3. METHOD OF ENTRY

- The promoter will announce the title and artist of the next "winning song" at random times Monday to Friday between 6am – 6pm. That nominated song will be broadcast at some time during the next 2-3 hours. When the winning song is broadcast, be the 5th caller through by phoning 03 56 222 444. The contestant will then be invited to our 100 Grand for Gippsland event to be able to go into the draw for the chance to win \$100,000 to be drawn at The Warragul Downtowner Monday June 24.
- Listeners have the chance to get onto the Invite Only list from Tuesday 11 June to Friday June 21 (weekends excluded)
- We will hold an outside broadcast at The Warragul Downtowner with all our invited listeners Monday June 24 between 6pm and 7pm.

At 6:30pm 24 June 2024 - 1 person will be drawn from the barrel from all those invited listeners in attendance and they will then get to choose from 100 envelopes numbered 1 to 100. They pick any number they want. One of the envelopes will have \$100,000. The other 99 envelopes will have a minimum \$1000. The winning envelope will be decided by the Insurance Company on the day. The odds of winning \$100,000 are 100/1. To win the \$100,000 the contestant must be present at The Warragul Downtowner. There will be no proxies.

4. NATURE, VALUE and DISTRIBUTION OF PRIZES:

1. Cash prize amounts will be direct deposited into a bank account nominated by the winner.
2. The promoter accepts no responsibility should the winner provide incorrect bank account details.
3. Should a winner fail to provide a bank account number within 14 days of the prize being awarded, the winner will forfeit the prize.
4. Any forfeited prizes become null and void.
5. Any taxes which may be payable as a consequence of a winner receiving the prize are the sole responsibility of that winner.
6. prizes are non-transferable

7. the Promoter and its employees and agents will be fully released from and indemnified by winner in respect of any claim for accident, injury, property damage or loss of life in connection with winner's participation in the contest.

5. PRIZE COLLECTION:

1. The promoter may request at its sole discretion a winner to present in person to validate their identity by providing ID which includes a photograph.
2. Upon request by the Promoter a copy of the general contest rules and/or a signed receipt and acknowledgement must be signed and endorsed by any winner to indicate his/her understanding and acceptance of these terms.
3. Prizes will only be awarded following winner validation and verification to the satisfaction of the promoter.
4. The judges' decision is **final**, and no correspondence will be entered into.

6. PUBLICITY:

Acceptance of a prize constitutes permission for the Promoter to use winner's name, suburb of residence, recording of winner's voice and likeness for advertising and promotional purposes without compensation, unless otherwise prohibited by law.

7. EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY:

The Promoter takes no responsibility for the loss of prizes due to incorrect or imprecise delivery details provided by an entrant. The Promoter makes no representations or warranties as to the quality/suitability/merchantability of any of the goods/services offered as prizes. To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter is not liable for any loss suffered or sustained to personal property and including, but not limited to, consequential (including economic) loss by reason of any act or omission, deliberate or negligent, by the Promoter, or its servants or agents, in connection with the arrangement for supply, or the supply, of any goods or services by any person to the prize winner(s) and, where applicable, to any persons accompanying the winners.

8. OWNERSHIP OF ENTRIES:

1. all entries (whether in written, audio or visual form, or a combination of those) become and remain the property of the Promoter (subject to the limits contained in the Privacy Statement).
2. all winners' names and contact details will be kept on record, including the prize value awarded to that person.

9. DISQUALIFICATION:

1. the Promoter is not responsible for lost, interrupted communications or unavailable network server or other connections, failed telephone, mid-delivery or computer transmissions or other errors of any kind, whether human, mechanical or electronic.
2. the Promoter assumes no responsibility for any error, defect, delay, theft or unauthorised access to or alternation of entries. Subject to any written directions given under the applicable law, if for any reason, the competition is not capable of operating as planned, including infection by computer viruses, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, or proper conduct of the competition, then the – Promoter reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this competition. The Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual for:
 1. tampering with the entry process, including exceeding any limitation on the numbers of entries, or any other process as determined by the Promoter that in any way affects the fairness of the promotion;
 2. tampering with the operation of the competition or web site;
 3. acting in violation of these terms and conditions;
 4. acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner; or
 5. if an entrant selected as winner is found to be in breach of paragraphs 3 or 4 of these conditions of entry, a new winner may be selected and, in the event that the entrant in breach has been awarded a prize, the entrant may be required to return the prize or reimburse the value of the prize to the Promoter.

10. PARTICIPATION:

Participation in the competition constitutes the entrant's unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these General Competition Entry Rules. These rules may change from time to time. The Entrant is responsible for insuring his or her familiarity with the General Competition Entry Rules at the time of participation. 11. DURATION OF THE PROMOTION

3GG's 100 Grand for Gippsland will commence on Tuesday 11th June 2024 and conclude at 6pm on Friday 21st June 2024. The Prize draw at the Warragul Downtowner June 24th 2024 at 6:30pm. All winners will be notified by telephone and announced on-air at the time of the prize draw.
